



What is a higher degree by research?





- Levels 9 (Masters) and 10 (Doctoral)
- Differentiates research and coursework degrees in both
- 2/3 research (defined)
- Specifies knowledge, skills, application and volume of learning
- Does not dictate eligibility or pathways

How is it funded?



- tuition fees offset
- stipend for general living costs
- allowances related to the ancillary cost of research degrees

Time and citizenship limitations
Defined application, selection and offer processes, leave entitlements
Increased flexibility – duration, value

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Education Standards for Overseas Students – ESOS



Standards with particular interpretations for HDRs include:

- Marketing information and practices
- Student engagement before enrolment
- Student support services
- Transfer
- Complaints and appeals
- Student visas
- Monitoring progress and attendance
- Deferring, suspending or cancelling the student's enrolment
- Staff capability, educational resources and premises
