Building an Industry Engagement Program

- HDR Strategy
 - Research and Innovation Future Makers
- HDR Industry Engagement Team
 - Professional staff team dedicated to HDR industry engagement (3 FTE)
 - Integrated into Graduate School central support team for all HDR industry engagement
 - Specialised roles (e.g. PhD internship specialists)
 - Working in close collaboration with other externally facing areas and Schools
 - Regular presence at student-facing events




Incentivisation and Support - examples

- PhD internships incentivised at all levels:
 - Internships integrated into regular candidature milestones for PhDs, with recognition on academic transcript
 - Extension of scholarship for eligible research internships
 - Performance metric:
 - For Faculties jointly set soft targets
 - For individual supervisors part of Individual Academic Profile
- Researcher Education and Development team support for industry engagement
 - For HDRs as part of Career and Research Skills Training (CaRST)
 - For supervisors as part of supervisor professional development
 - For EMCRs as part of the Developing Positive Partnerships Program
