

(1422 universities)









Number of universities in QS top 500 (2025) and population of each state/territory –




Number of universities total in each state/territory (with QS rankings — 2025)

Positive settings in New Zealand

- Government treats international PhD students as domestic
- Fees considerably lower than Australia
 - Australia: UQ \$44k-\$55k RMIT \$33k-38k
 - New Zealand: UoA \$8k VUW \$8k–10k

all values in AUD per year

- International PhD students attract government funding
 - An extra \$21k-\$51k per year per student
